Younger son of Richard II, Duke of Normandy, and father of William the Conqueror of England by his mistress Arlette. After the death of his father he contested the claim of his older brother to the duchy. He supported Henry I of France against his younger brother and received the Vexain Francais Territory north of Paris as a reward. He died while returning from a pilgrimage to Jerusalem.

6. King⁶ William I Conqueror of England, Count/ofNormandy (I Duke of Normandy "The Devil" "The Magnificent", 5)³. Born, 1027, in Falaise, Normandy, France. Died, 9 Sep 1087, in Rouen, France. Occupation: KingofEngland.

Count of Normandy 1035-87; Duke William II of Normandy, and King of England 1066-87. Son of Robert I of Normandy, who died while returning from a pilgrimage to Jerusalem, and his concubine Herleva. He acceded as a child, and three of his guardians died violent deaths. He was knighted at age 15, in 1042, and dealt with a number of rebellions from 1046 to 1055. He married Matilda, daughter of Baldwin V of Flanders in 1052. His four sons were Robert, Duke of Normandy; Richard (died young), William II Roufus, King of England, and King Henry of England. His daughter Adela was mother of Stephen, King of England. William I defeated King Harold of England in the Battle of Hastings, and claimed the English throne, being crowned on Christmas day 1066 at Westminster Abbey.

One of the most able kings to rule Scotland & morally fastidious. Sense of justice + duty. Ruled for his brother in South Lothian from ca 1113. Modernized the realm. Introduced feudal system. Spent his formative years at court of Henry I, etc. uniform heights & measures etc etc

Upon Henry I death he marched on England until defeated at Battle of Stansted 22 Aug 1138. He failed to suggest Maud's claim to the crown except in 1141. King Stephen ceded Northumbria to Maud's sister of Henry I in 1139.

She married <Saint> David I King of Scots¹², son of Malcomb III Canmore King of Scots and Saint Margaret Saxon Queen of Scots. Born, circa 1082. Died, 24 May 1153, in Carlisle, Cumberland, Scot..

Included in the Scotch Calendar of Saints in the King James Version of the Bible, however he was not canonized by the Catholic Church.

The youngest son of King Malcom III Canmore of Scotland, he was also Earl of Huntingdon, and was one of the most powerful Scottish Kings, introducing the English feudal system into the South of Scotland. He was an outstanding patron of the Roman church. He spent much of his early life at the English court with his brother in law King Henry I of England who married his sister Edith, who took the name Matilda. He became King of Scots in 1124 upon the death of his brother Alexander I, who had earlier allowed him to rule Cumbria Strathclyde and part of Lothian. He frequently changed political sides, but generally fought in support of the claims of his widowed sister Matilda to the throne of England. Children:

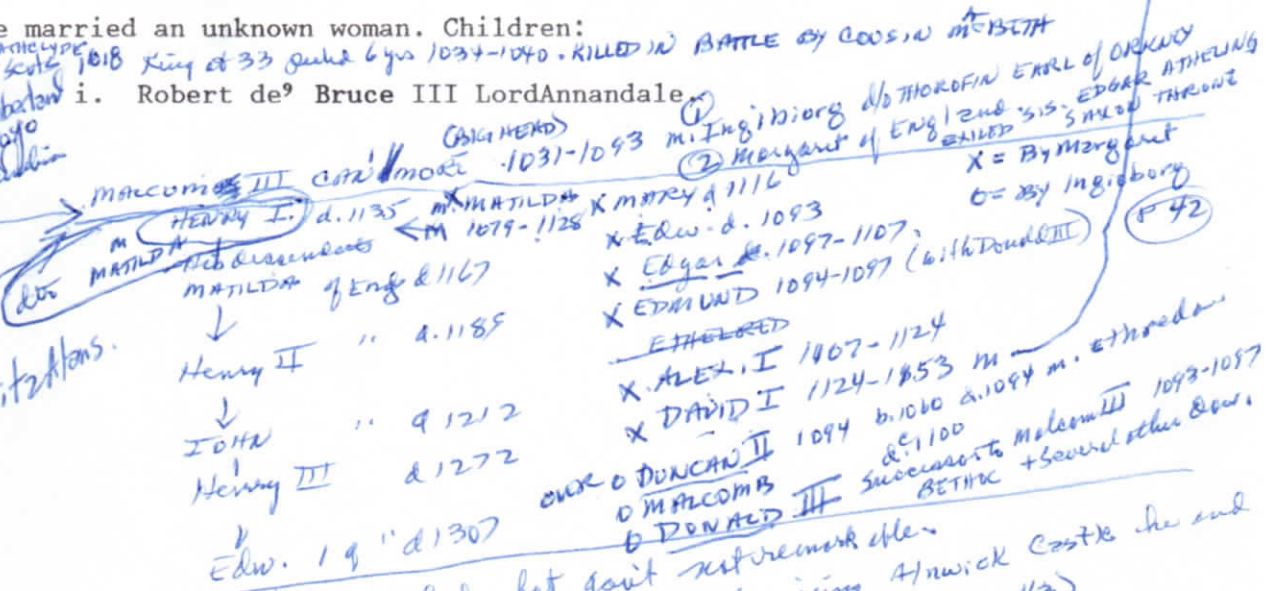

In 1304 he took a final position in 1304 when he made the bond of Combar Kenneth with Bishop Lamberton of St. Andrews, head of the Scottish Church. In Feb. 1306 he met John "the Red Comyn" in Greyfriars Church, Dumfries, and established him to death at the altar. ~~Comyn was 74~~ He then made his way to Scone where he was proclaimed King, endorsed by the Curia Regia ~~1566~~ (Monarchs 75-6)

He was torn between loyalty to his country and his feudal superior King Edward I. He changed sides 5 times Monarchs 874

FOURTEENTH GENERATION

20. Robert VIII King Robert I the¹⁴ Bruce (Robert VII Earl of Carrick, 19)¹⁷. Born, 12 Mar 1274, in Scotland. Died, 7 Jun 1329, in Cardross, Scotland. Burial: 1329, in Abbey Church of, Dunferline. ~~Age 32~~

Known to the Scots as 'Good King Robert'

The fourteenth century champion of Scottish independence from England, he reigned as King of Scotland from 1306 to 1329 before becoming also King of England in 1328. He was earlier Earl of Carrick, his father having resigned in his favor in 1292, and the 5th Lord Annandale. The previous king having died without heirs, Robert asserted his right to the Scottish throne through his mother's right, but was denied by Edward I of England, who wanted the throne for himself, and who attempted to have him assassinated.

He and his followers are believed to have murdered his competitor for the throne of Scotland, John Comyn, a nephew of John de Balioll, Feb. 10, 1306. He hastened to Scone and was crowned March 25, 1306. He was twice defeated by the English in 1306. His wife and many followers were captured, and three of his brothers executed, leaving only Edward to support him when he returned from being a fugitive at Rathlin to Ayrshire. In 1307 he defeated a major Eng. force at Loudoun

He raised an army and prepared to meet Edward's vastly superior forces, but Edward died and was succeeded by Edward II who invaded Scotland. Robert awaited him at Bannock burn (creek) June 24, 1314, inflicted 30,000 casualties on Edward's 100,000 man army. Robert again defeated Edward II at Biland Abbey in Yorkshire, becoming also King Robert I of England. (Monarchs 876)

Upon his death, he had Sir James Douglas remove his heart and take it on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Douglas was killed enroute, and it is reported that the heart was returned and buried at Melrose Abbey.

First of the Stewart, later Stuart dynasty to rule in Scotland and later in England. High Steward of Scotland, he was the son of Robert I's daughter Marjorie, and was heir presumptive to his maternal Grandfather Robert Bruce until a son, King David II was born. He was often joint regent during David's period of exile and imprisonment. He succeeded David on his death Feb. 22, 1371. *at age 54*

after 3 years of feeble govt, Robt II acknowledged his own ineffectiveness and handed over authority to his eldest son John, Earl of Carrick, who 4 years later

and ruled from 1371 to 1390. From 1384 the kingdom was administered by his eldest son John, Earl of Carrick, who became King Robert III.
He married Elizabeth Mure after the birth of several children, and 2nd Euphemia Ross in 1355 by whom he had Walter, Earl of Atholl who plotted the murder of James I, another son and two daughters. He also had eight known illegitimate sons *He died of Leprosy 1504*
His successors were: Robert III, who was his son James by birth (1390-1406); James I (1406-37); James II (1437-60); James III (1460-88); James IV (1488-1513), James V (1513-42); Mary, Queen of Scots (1542-67); James VI (1567- who then became King James I of England).
