PREFACE

The probate records of the Prerogative Court of Maryland contain several types of records: testamentary proceedings, wills, administration accounts, inventories, accounts and inventories, and distributions. Each kind of record has value for the genealogist. Prior to 1777, all probate records were required to be filed with the Prerogative Court of Maryland.

An inventory was performed if the estate had moveable goods. The inventory included a listing of such things as clothes, household items, negroes, occupational tools. (A particular type of inventory cited debts due to the estate.) Items in the inventory reveal a great deal about the decedent and the family, especially his wealth, occupation, and manner of living. As part of the inventory, names of several other persons might be cited: appraiser(s) of the estate, creditors, next of kin (or relations), legatees, and administrators or executors.

All names are cited in the index; however, a name may appear more than once on a particular page. All efforts have been made to correctly interpret the names. However, sometimes the handwriting was difficult or impossible to read. The reader should refer to the original liber or photo-copy thereof when possible. No attempt has been made to coordinate differences in the spelling of names. Copies of any particular inventory or inventories can be obtained either via microfilm from the library of the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter Day Saints, or via photoduplication from the Maryland State Archives (350 Rowe Boulevard, Annapolis, Maryland 21401).

All dates prior to 14 September 1752 have been specified in Old Style format. However, the denotation "(OS)" has not been specified. (Thus, the date January 1, 1751/2 will be written as Jan 1 1751.)

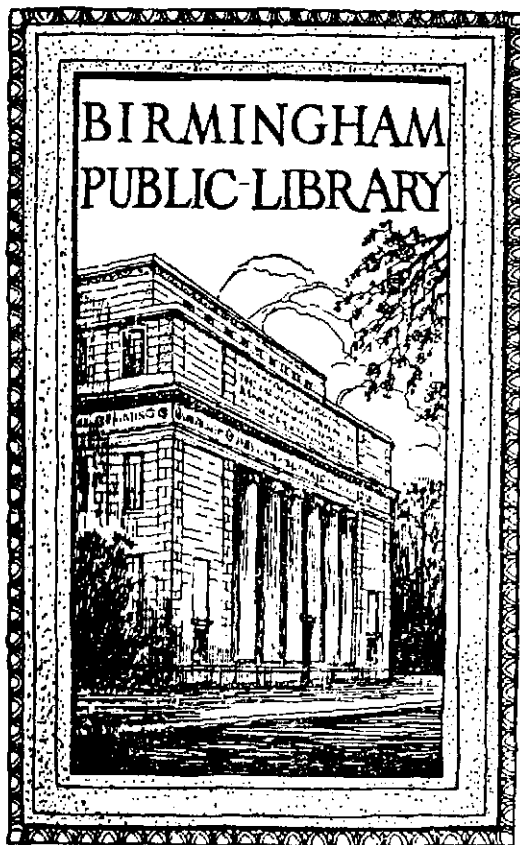

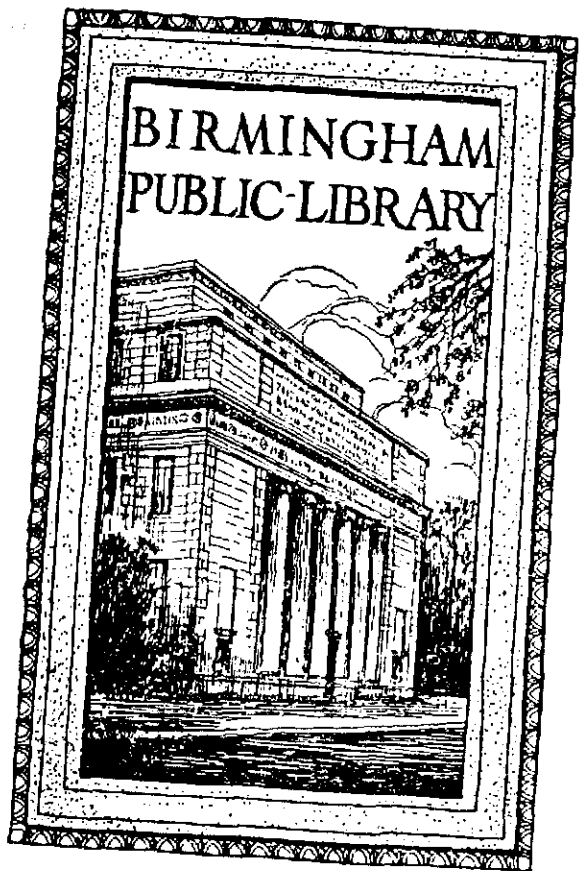

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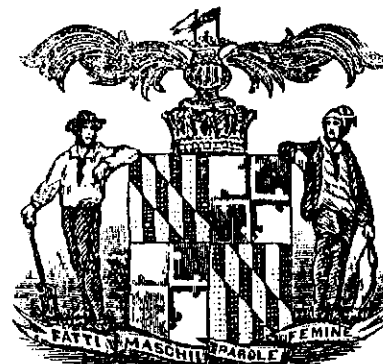
