Dear Madam:

Reference is made to your letter relative to Samuel Bryan, a soldier of the Revolutionary War.

The data contained herein were obtained from the papers on file in the Revolutionary War claim for pension, W. 9366, based upon the military service of Samuel Bryan in that war.

Samuel Bryan's great grandfather Bryan was a Dane and lived in Denmark until his son Morgan was born, when he moved to Ireland; his name and that of his wife are not stated. Morgan when he became of age emigrated to America and settled in Pennsylvania, where he married Martha Strode, a Hollander whose parents had moved to France and in order to escape persecution because of their religion started for Pennsylvania and died at sea leaving three children: Jeremiah, Samuel and Martha, who were provided for by their shipmates until of age, when Martha married Morgan Bryan. Their children were: Joseph, Elenor, Mary, Samuel, Morgan, John, William, James, and Thomas Bryan.

William married Mary, daughter of Sarah Morgan and Squire Boone and sister of Colonel Daniel Boone; they lived in Rowan County, North Carolina until they had ten children: Samuel, Daniel, William, Phebe, Hannah, John, Sarah, Abner, Elizabeth and Mary. In 1779 they moved to Kentucky and settled at Bryans Station on Elkhorn Creek in Fayette County, where the Indians killed him and his son William.

His son, Samuel, (W. 9366) the Revolutionary War pensioner, while residing in Rowan County, North Carolina, enlisted in July 1777 and served nine months at various times as a private under Captains William Bayley Smith, John Holder, William Hogan and Colonels Benjamin Logan of the Virginia troops and Captains Johnson and James Stinson and Colonel Isaacs of the North Carolina troops

and was in General George R. Clarke's expedition and in the engagement with Indians at the Piqua towns.

He was allowed pension on his application executed August 18, 1832, while living in Marion County, Indiana, aged seventy-six years. He died March 4, 1837.

Soldier married October 5, 1775, in Rowan County, North Carolina, Mary, daughter of Isabella and Colonel Jonathan Hunt. She was allowed pension on her application executed December 18, 1839, while living in Marion County, Indiana, with sons, Luke and Thomas, at which time she was eighty-seven years old.

Their children: Ann; Phebe; William; Abner; Luke, born November 22, 1784, married in 1807, Mary, daughter of Sarah and Captain John Sanders; Thomas; Sarah; Mary; Daniel; Hampton and Samuel.

Dear Madam:

Reference is made to your letter in which you state that you desire another record of George Bryan, Revolutionary War soldier (S. 32142) to file with an application for membership in the Society of the Daughters of the American Colonies. The record of that soldier follows as found in the papers of pension claim, S. 32142, based upon his service in the Revolutionary War.

George Bryan was born February 15, 1758, in Rowan County, North Carolina; the names of his parents were not given. In the spring of 1776 he went to work at a place in Kentucky where Bryan's Station was erected, but in July of that year returned to his home in Rowan County, North Carolina, where he found the people of the frontiers of Virginia, North and South Carolina and Georgia flying before the Cherokee Indians.

He volunteered in August, 1776, served three months some days as private and spy in Captain Samuel Mosby's company, Colonel Williams' North Carolina regiment, went to Long Island on Holston River, assisted in burning fourteen towns of the Cherokee Indians and destroying their corn, and was discharged the last of November or first of December, 1776. Sometime in the summer of 1778, he being drafted to serve in Captain John Johnston's company, Colonel Lock's North Carolina regiment, hired a substitute who served eighteen months in his place. He moved to Kentucky in the spring of 1779, settled where Bryan's Station was located, assisted in building a small fort there and was in constant skirmishes about that place with the Cherokee Indians, length of this tour three months. He then returned to North Carolina to assist his father's family in moving to Kentucky. They arrived

at Bryan's Station in December, 1779. He volunteered at Bryan's Station, Kentucky, served from December 18, 1779, as private in Captain William Hogan's company engaged in hunting and spying, killed three Indians and brought in thirty-four horses and was discharged September 20, 1780.

The soldier moved the last of September, 1780, back to North Carolina, and after the war lived in Rowan County, that state, and in Fayette, Bourbon and Nicholas Counties, in the State of Kentucky.

George Bryan was allowed pension on his application executed February 24, 1834, while residing in Nicholas County, Kentucky. In 1845, he was living in the State of Illinois near his children who were living there, in Sangamon County, his post office being Springfield. No reference was made to soldier's wife.

George Bryan's brother, Joseph Bryan, served with him on one campaign against the Indians, and in 1834 was living in Fayette County, Kentucky. One William Bryan, Junior, was killed by Indians at Boonsborough near Bryant's Station in Kentucky, his relationship to George not shown.

Daniel Bryan who was born about February 10, 1758, in North Carolina, a "full cousin" of the soldier, George Bryan, came to Kentucky with him in the spring of 1779, served in the Revolution with him on a campaign under Captain John Johnston, was in 1834 a resident of Nicholas County, Kentucky.
