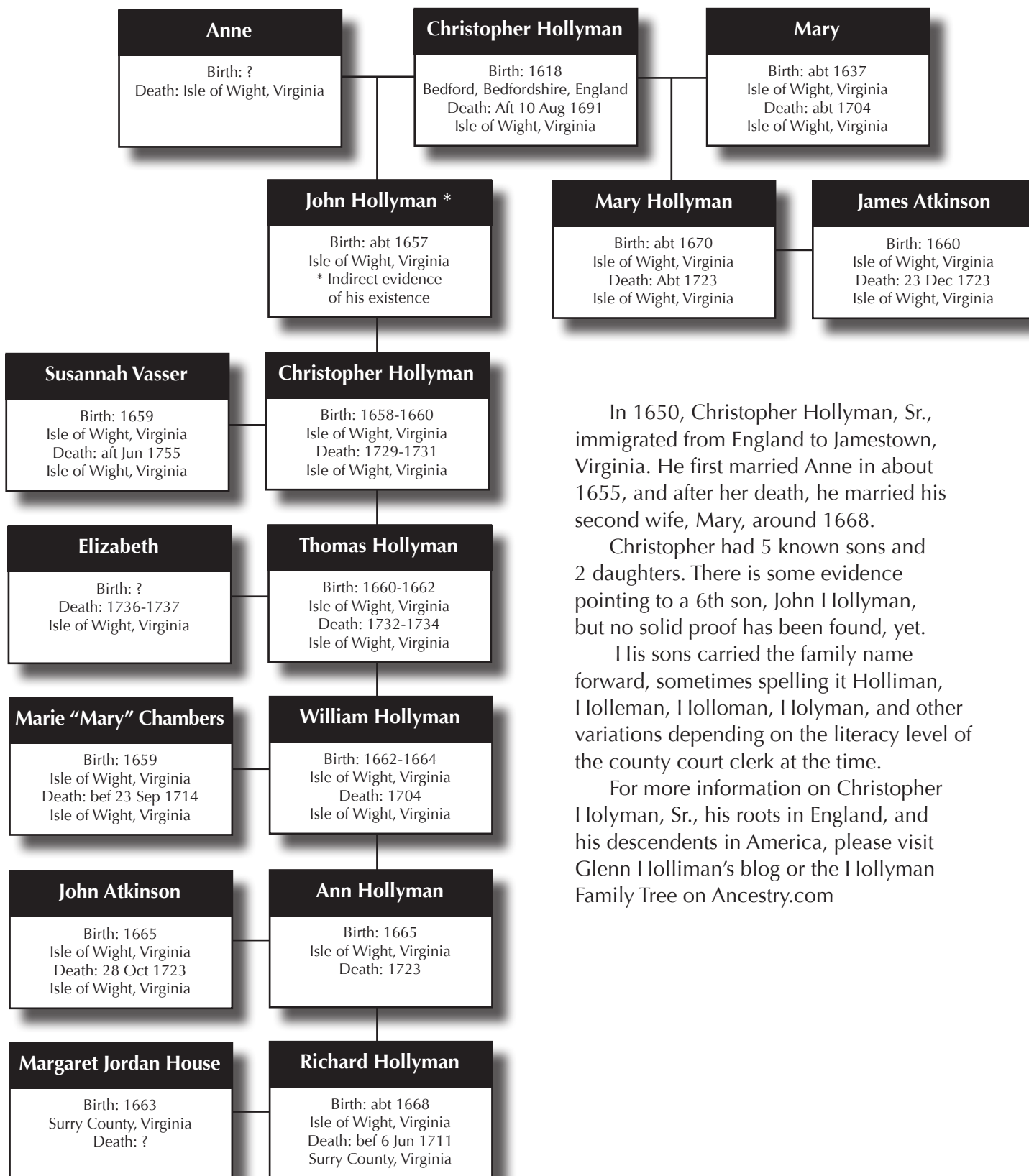


Christopher Hollyman, Sr. of Isle of Wight, Virginia and His Children



In 1650, Christopher Hollyman, Sr., immigrated from England to Jamestown, Virginia. He first married Anne in about 1655, and after her death, he married his second wife, Mary, around 1668.

Christopher had 5 known sons and 2 daughters. There is some evidence pointing to a 6th son, John Hollyman, but no solid proof has been found, yet.

His sons carried the family name forward, sometimes spelling it Holliman, Holleman, Holloman, Holyman, and other variations depending on the literacy level of the county court clerk at the time.
