

SOME DAVIDSON ANCESTORS OF INTEREST

HAWKINS: Several Biographies have been written about Sir John, who was Treasurer of the Royal Navy during the Elizabethan Era. He was third in command at the defeat of the Spanish Armada, but is best known as the "Architect of the Elizabethan Navy", whose redesign of the British Navy was the real reason for the victory. He was a shipowner, an explorer, sailed as a Privateer under Letters of Marque from Elizabeth, who was his partner, and is credited with being the originator of the slave trade in the Caribbean.

HAWKINS-CROCKETT: Our ancestor Margaret "Polly" Hawkins was the daughter of Nicholas Hawkins, whose sister Rebecca married John Crockett, and they were the parents of Davy Crockett of Alamo fame. Margaret was his first cousin, as are we--a few times removed.

EGERTON: During the 1600's Charles, a descendant of a noble English family, was on two different Maryland juries which convicted two women of witchcraft and ordered them hanged. His descendants moved later to Virginia, then to North Carolina, where Wilmot Egerton became the Patriarch of the family which intermarried with the Riggans.

SMITH: Capt. (later Col.) John Smith and 4 of his sons fought in the French and Indian Wars. Two of his sons were killed at the surrender of Ft. Vause, which he commanded, and he was taken as a prisoner to France. He was irate when they refused to let him fight in the Revolution at age 82. I recently visited the home of his son Henry, Sr., built about 1752 and still being lived in. Henry fought in the French and Indian Wars as a young man, and as a Sgt. in the Revolution as an old man. His home at Smith's Ford, York County, S. C. was used as a staging point for the Rebels, and when General Sumter was wounded he was taken by Henry's sons to the home of their father.

ALEXANDER: At Bullock's Creek, S. C. there are several monuments to the Rev. Joseph Alexander, the fiery patriot and Presbyterian preacher who turned his home into a hospital and place of refuge for the Whigs. The British had a price on his head, and the men and boys of the area stood armed guard while he preached. In his will he indicates that he and his eldest son, Dr. Samuel Davies Alexander are never likely to reach an agreement on anything during his lifetime. The son apparently lived up to his father's doubts, since his brothers and sisters were forced to sue to recover their inheritance from their grandfather, Samuel Davies, after Dr. Samuel Davies Alexander went to N. C., had the grandfather's will set aside, had himself and a brother-in-law appointed administrators, sold the assets, pocketed the money, and fled to Alabama.

BRYAN: Richard, probably a descendant of the Boone-Bryan clan who settled at Bryans Station and Boones Station in Kentucky, but which is not proven, married Margaret Hawkins in Christian County. KY in

1810, and moved to Washington County, Mississippi Territory about 1819, where he was an employee of the Choctaw Indian Agency near what is now Livingston in Sumter County, AL. He died when his son Jesse was only four. Jesse became the Sheriff of Pickens County, and was a celebrated story teller, "known to every man, woman, and child in Pickens County."

RIGGAN: Jeremiah, who came to Mississippi in the early 1820's was one of the biggest landholders in Monroe County, and is one of the few Davidson ancestors who did not come through South Carolina.

CURTIS: John Alexander Curtis, who was taken prisoner at least three times during the Civil War, died only three years after his marriage to Columbia Bryan, and when Elflada was only one. He and his brother, James H. and sister-in-law Mary owned the Columbus Hotel in Columbus, MS. We know he was born in S. C. about 1826, but have been unable to establish his parentage.

DAVIDSON: The author recently located a photo of James A. Davi(d)son who came to America from Ireland about 1798 as a boy with his brother Andrew. It appears that their father was also a James, and that all three moved to Mississippi in 1840 from York County, SC. James A. later moved across the line to Alabama to a place he named Millville, later known as Detroit. James A. and Andrew were naturalized in 1813, and lived near the Smith's, Alexanders, and Guyton's along the Broad River in SC. James A. amassed a large amount of land, much of which went to the heirs of the Rev. Jesse Carter, second husband of his son William Washington Davidson's wife, Mary Elizabeth Riggan.

GUYTON: This French Huguenot family fled to England in the early 1600's, settling later in Baltimore County, MD, then moving to Union County, SC about 1756, where they were active Baptists. Although in Union County, they lived just across the Broad River from the Alexanders and Davidsons, and near the Smith's.

DESCENDANTS OF COL. JOHN SMITH SOCIETY

This group of fifty or so had a first reunion at Clemson, SC last June where we toured the Pendleton Historical Society Museum, a number of cemeteries, and located home sites of some ancestors. A second reunion is planned for the summer of 1994, to be held in the Broad River area, including a tour of Henry Smith's home. Let me know if you need information on this reunion.
