Elfleda Curtis was the only child of John A. Curtis and Columbia Lenora Bryan Curtis and was born in Columbus, Miss. May 17, 1868. After the death of her father which occurred May 10, 1869, she and her mother lived with Columbia's mother, Mrs. Jesse W. Bryan, until December 30, 1875 when Columbia married Capt. John S. White and shortly thereafter the family moved to Pipeville, Alabama.

On September 23, 1885 Elfleda was married to James Andrew Davidson in Detroit, Alabama and the following children were born to them:
