County Road # 12. The church is on the north side and
the cemetery is across the road.

Mary (Polly) Lucas Holliman - born Jan. 2, 1819 died July 5, 1913

Inscription: "PIONEER STRENGHT INTEGRITY HUMAN KINDNESS"

It is believed that Jennie Holliman (daughter of Joshua Warren "Bud" Holliman) had this marker placed at Mary Polly's gravesite.

The marker is a larger granite monument of superior quality which appropriately signifies Mary Polly's importance to the people of Fayette County.

Springhill Cemetery (near Bluff in Fayette Co.) - continued:

* The above old monument is sitting adjacent to a modern granite monument that contains 3 names as follows:

Mollie Holliman - born 1872 - died 1934 Isaiah Holliman - born 1870 - died 1954 Virgie Holliman - born 1895 - died 1965

Explanation of the above follows:
Isaiah Holliman is the same person as J. I. Holliman.
Mollie Holliman was Isaiah's first wife and therefore
the other monument which is placed about 6 inches away
from the new monument belongs to Mollie which is one
and the same as M. M. Langston. I conclude that
Mollie has her name on 2 different monuments.

Located approximately 4 miles west of Bluff on a paved county road on left at top of hill overlooking a lake. The Cemetery, located in a grove of large pine tree, has a sign affixed to a tree that reads "Stewart Cemetery". The cemetery was started by the Stewart Family and expanded to include the Holliman Family upon James Franklin Holliman's marriage to Rebecca Utley Stewart.

Additional notations about Stewart - Holliman Cemetery:

Many "unidentified graves" are contained within this cemetery. They are marked only with rocks, one at head and one at foot. It is assumed that they were those of the Stewart family dating from very early times.

Other graves that are marked included J. F. Holliman's brother-in-law, William M. Stewart, and various members of his immediate family.
