Union County began to be settled by Scots-Irish led by James McIlwaine in 1751. The rolling countryside was mostly forest, as it is again today. (p. 2)

The migration in the 1820's & '30's was occasioned by the exhaustion or infertility of the soil, commercial fertilizers not then being available.

The Quakers, who began settling in Union Co. in the 1750's, left the country between 1800 and 1810. Never popular because of the pacifism which kept most if not all from fighting in the Revolution, they also objected to the increasing practice of slavery by their neighbors, ~~while they stayed~~.  
By 1809 only 18 Quakers were left at Cane Creek Meeting, the building having been sold in 1805. Many moved to SW Ohio and SE Indiana. (p. 10-11)

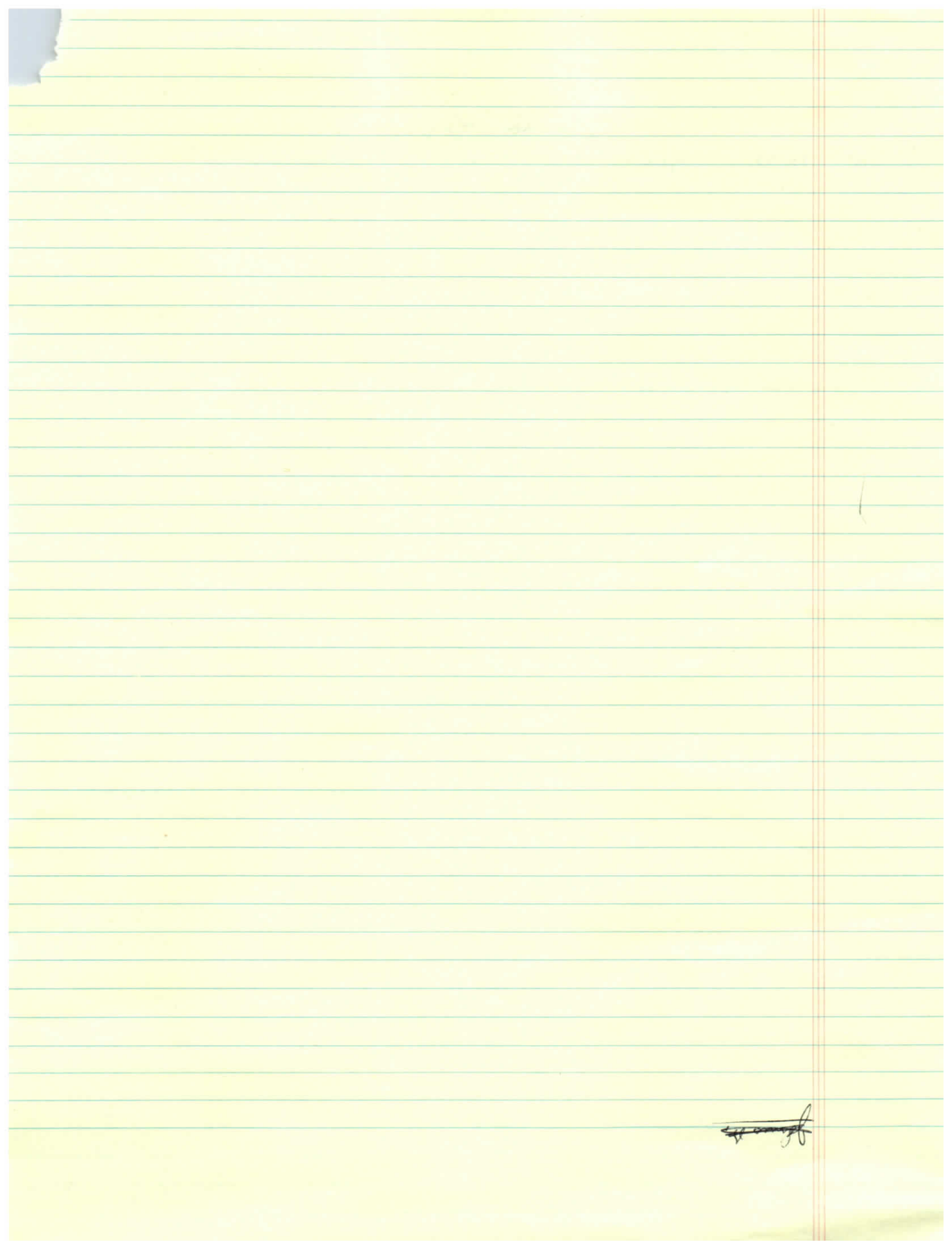
