
John Thomas Holliman - b. 04/23,1844 - d. 07/12/1930 Civil War Soldier - Served in Company "H" of 41st -Alabama Infantry Regiment, C.S.A. Enlisted at Fayette County Court House April 20, 1862. He was in the Battle of Chickamauga, Battle of Murfeesboro, Battle Above the Clouds (at Chattanooga) and other actions including the Seige of Petersburg, Virginia, at which he and comrades John South, Miles Bobo, -et.al. surrendered to Federals on February 16, 1865, approximately 2 months before the end of the war. John Thomas Holliman was parolled to a farmer near Indianapolis, Indiana, where he remained until war ended. Along with other soldiers he walked home, which he said was nothing compared to the suffering, hardships, exposure to weather, starvation and lack of clothing he had faced in Trenches of Petersburg. John Thomas Holliman was called "Hico John" since he lived near the old Hico Post Office below Fayette on Gordo Road. He was a farmer and school teacher.
