Emory O. Holliman (08H27)

Emory O. Holliman, the secretary and treasurer of the Gulf Furniture Company and a senior partner of the well-known firm, Holliman, Childree, & Ramsey public accountants, in Mobile, is prominently identified with this community's varied activities.

During the past years he has made his mark in business, professional, civic, fraternal and social affairs and has become affiliated with a number of more important organizations.

Holliman was born in Vernon, July 10, 1893, son of J. W. and Martha C. (Goolsby) Holliman. His father, a native of Fayette County, was an established farmer of his district. Emory O. Holliman, of whom this account is written, attended the local schools and then furthered his education at University of Alabama, from which he was graduated in 1919 with the degree of Bachelor of Science.

Emory O. Holliman engaged in the accounting business in Mobile under his own name prior to his starting the Gulf Furniture Company. He started this concern on a small scale at 260 St. Francis Street. The venture proved so successful that its growth required its removal to larger quarters. The concern was then moved to its building on Dauphin Street, which provided eighteen thousand square feet of floor space, and has continued at this address down to the time of writing. The Gulf Furniture Company gives gainful employment to thirty persons and the bulk of its business is done within a fifty-mile radius. It also has a large warehouse. Mr. G. C. Outlaw is president and Mr. Holliman is the secretary and treasurer of the company, which has become one of the leading concerns of its kind in this area. Mr. Holliman is also a senior partner of the prominent accounting firm of Holliman, Childree, and Ramsey.

Mr. Holliman is a member of the following organizations: the Ancient Masons, in which he has attained the thirty second degree of the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite, the Abba Temple of the Ancient Arabic Order of Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, the Kiwanis Club, the Mobile Country Club, the Athelstan Club and the Chamber of Commerce. He belongs to the Baptist Church.

Emory O. Holliman married June 3, 1920, Emma V. Ramsey, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A. C. Ramsey of Carbon Hill, and they are parents of a daughter Ann R. Holliman who was born July 10, 1925, a graduate of Randolph-Mason College.

CORNELIUS HOLLIMAN (05H01), b. 1792 - d. 1862, is believed to have had a number of sisters and brothers. Our study is directed toward Cornelius Holliman (05H01) and two of his brothers, Warren Holliman (05H02) and Charles Holliman (05H03). While we purport to tell the story of the Hollimans in Alabama we confine our immediate study to these three Hollimans. According to the story that has been passed down by generations of family members, these three Holliman brothers came to Alabama on a "hunting trip", spent the winter and returned to Anson County, North Carolina in the spring of 1836. They gathered their personal belongings and returned with their families to Alabama, settling in the southern part of Fayette County. These three brothers purchased land near Newtonville, in Fayette County, Alabama. Cornelius purchased 40 acres of land formerly known as the Yerby Place.

Warren Holliman (05H02) purchased 40 acres of land just west of the present location of Old Shepherd Baptist Church. Warren moved to the Hot Springs, Arkansas, area (CA 1840). He changed the spelling of his name to Holiman. Information has been accumulated by various family members for publication in " Hot Springs Township History ". Warren Holliman's story will be told in " The Hollimans of Arkansas " part of this book .

Charles Holliman's (05H03) purchased 80 acres of land that is exactly where the Old Shepherd Baptist Church and Cemetery in now located. He remained in the Newtonville area of Fayette County where some of his descendants lived and branched out into the surrounding counties.

To clarify our picture of the earliest Hollimans to arrive in Alabama I have constructed the following chart. In reviewing this chart keep in mind it does not show a complete picture. As we previously stated, Cornelius, Warren, and Charles had other brothers and sisters. Only these three brothers are shown because thus far we've limited our study to those Hollimans that migrated to Alabama. Following this chart the Charles Hollimans (05H03) story is presented as we know it today. Admittedly it is far from complete. While some information is forever lost to us, "new" discoveries are always possible and may be added.
