

## The Parish Registers

The word, parish is a term originally used for the district assigned to a bishop or priest usually formed on the basis of a previously existing manor or township.

There are about fifteen thousand civil parishes in England and Wales and fifteen hundred in Scotland varying greatly in extent and population.

The parish was for many years the unit of administration for the poor, law and highway purposes but is no longer so. Parishes included in the area of rural district councils have through the parish council or parish meeting certain powers in local government and can for instance complain to the county council when the rural district council is held at fault on matters of housing or public health.

The parochial church council deals with matters connected to the parish church. If we take a look at some cases of bastardy contained in this work, the position of the parish church council becomes clear.

Parish registers were and still are in many areas, kept as a matter of law: law brought about by Thomas Cromwell but as there were far more churches than there were and still are in some outlying villages, ministers to preach, the cleric, as they were known in early years, became confused or indolent in the recording of events of his ministry.

One particular parish is brought to mind is that of Wraxall where I know no Hollymans lived there but its registers record no fewer than fourteen burials.

Situated in the parish churchyard of Weston in Gordano is a 'double bedder' grave which has obviously more than one occupant yet its registers record only one, that of Sarah Hollyman nee Parsley. It seems strange that a wife should be buried alone when her husband and children's burials have been recorded in a church registers only a short distance away. (St Andrews)

On one of the pages of parchment comprising the parish register of St. Michael's and All Angels, Clapton in Gordano, there is an account of the building of a new pew. Dated 1699, it reads,

'This year in the month of October was built the Pew between the Church pew and the Chancel for the use of those who belong to the Society of Singers for ever no other persons (although they are of the posterity of those who built it) being ever to be admitted to sit therein except they are of the Society. It is erected at the expence of ye persons underwritten who gave the several sums following.

Charles Ewart Hollyman. Born in the year 1898 was married to, Nell in 1921. He worked as a general foreman at a well known building company in Cardiff. They had one daughter, Beryl who is still alive and well and is married with several children and lives in the Cardiff area.

Charlie, as he was generally known was always the life and soul of the party and shone at funerals. He died at the age of 79 in 1977 in Cardiff.

Much of this searching has been done by Mr W.D. Hollyman, a nephew of Ann Grace Tranter nee Hollyman. She it was who kept a small diary in which she recorded many, if not all her family events.

I have failed to find the registration of Beryl's birth unless the name used was a second one and that her first is one she did not use. Further searches needed.

Locations as yet,unknown

Before the year 1733.

Due to the loss of many of the pages which comprise the parish registers of St Andrews,Clevedon,plus the,as yet undiscovered locations of other marriages,we may never know the maiden names of the partners concerned. Only extensive searches will reveal them.

John Hollyman the elder married his first wife,RACHAEL some time during or before 1698.They were not married at St Michaels in Clapton nor Yatton.

John Hollyman,the same as above married Ann his second wife some time after he lost Rachael who died in 1700.A perusal of St John parish register at Westbury on Trym failed to reveal and Hollyman marriage niether was there one in the next parish,that of Henbury.It is probable that they married in Clevedon,the record of which was lost.

Emmanuel Hollyman who married HANNAH possibly around 1707.I know he moved with his family to Backwell but with regards to where he came from is not known.Although he lived for a time at Clapton Court,there is no mention of any Hollyman marriage except for Phoebe Hollyman with Mr A.Gregorie.

Oswald Hollyman the son of Roger and Rachael must I feel have married in Clevedon around the year 1729. He moved to Clevedon in most likely his early teens for by that time,his uncle John (elder)was well and truly established.

John Hollyman who was the elder's eldest son married MARTHA qyite possibly in Clevedon round about the year 1732.

Hezekiah Hollyman the other son of the elder married ANN possibly in Clevedon around the year 1733,another of the lost parish records.

The only other marriage which I have failed to find is that of Thomas Hollyman who married Martha Phillips. It may be that they married in one of the parish churches of Bristol for it was in this city that many of the 'rural'Hollymans married.It has been thought that his wife was related to

Emily Parsons. Born in 1846.Nothing else known.

Francis Parsons. Born in 1850.Nothing else known.

The Children on Sarah and David Harding.

Emma Maria Harding. Born in 1860 married Charles Tutty in 1883.Charles was born in 1856 and died in 1924.Emma outlived her husband by many years when she died in 1959 aged 99 years.

Alice Harding.It is not known exactly when she was born but she died aged twenty.Searches may be resumed at a later date.

Fanny Harding.Nothing known.

Sarah Ann Harding. As above

Lily Mabel Harding.Born in 1867 died in 1956 aged 89 years.Married to Mr A,J,Goodyer who also died in 1956.No issue.

Thomas Hollyman

1793 - 1867

The third son of Samuel and Anne Hollyman nee Wall was born in Puxton on May 22nd 1793 and baptised in St Saviours on January 8th 1794. He married Esther Lyons in Bristol on October 24th 1820. Esther was a Yatton girl born there in 1797. Thomas died aged 75 and buried at All Saints in Clevedon on December 23rd 1867. Esther is thought to have died in 1878 aged 83. Of this union, there was issue of:-

Hezekiah Hollyman born in Clevedon and baptised on August 19th 1821. He

worked as a pork butcher and was married Matilda Alice Scunett at St Mary's Redcliffe, Bristol in 1850. Matilda was six years younger. Hezekiah died aged 46 on September 14th 1867. Of this union, there was no issue.

Ann Hollyman. Nothing known except baptised on June 6th 1824

Louise Hollyman. Baptised on September 17th 1826. She lived with Hezekiah for a time and died unmarried aged 39 and buried November 24th 1865. Mentioned in census returns.

William Hollyman. Baptised on August 24th 1828 was also a butcher. He was married to Myrah Heath who died aged 42 and buried in Clevedon on September 3rd 1872: William died the following year and was buried on October 1st 1873. There were six children.

Thomas Hollyman was baptised on March 17th 1834 and he too lived with his brother for a time. Became a publican. Nothing else known.

Alfred Hollyman. Born in 1838 and baptised on October 14th 1839 died aged 3 years and buried May 13th 1841.

The Issue of Charles Hollyman and Eliza Griffin.

Charles was the son of Thomas and Elizabeth Hollyman nee Pitt. He was born on August 1st 1795. He married Eliza the fifth child of John and Martha Griffin. Born on August 9th 1801, she married Charles Hollyman in Clevedon on April 7th 1818. They had, as far as I know, only four children but, only one appears to have survived to adulthood. It may, of course because of the intermarrying of these two families for Martha, Eliza's mother was also a Hollyman and her husband was the son of Mary Hollyman, daughter of Hezekiah and Ann. They had their first child two years after they were married:-

William Hollyman who was born on September 3rd 1820 and baptised on March 17th 1822. He died at the age of six years and buried on August 7th 1826.

Joseph Hollyman was baptised on March 17th 1822 and since I commenced this research, I have seen nothing of him. Nothing else known.

Charles Hollyman. Baptised on January 24th 1825. He too died young at the age of three years and buried on August 7th 1828.

Eliza Hollyman the youngest child was baptised on August 24th 1826. She too died young but did reach seven years old. She was buried on March 29th 1833.

A truly tragic family. I found no trace of Eliza's burial and no sign of her in the census returns of Clevedon, Kenn or Yatton.

This family lived at Highdale farm and after the death of Charles, there appeared a notice of sale in the Bristol Mirror.

In the Quarter Sessions Court transcripts we find evidence of local lifestyle.

In 1616,Mary Gaynard was sentenced to be publically whipped for bearing an illegitimate child.She and the man she claimed to be the father had to give

money to the Parish to raise a fund for the child's upkeep and if she refused to keep the child herself,she was to pay 12d weekly.Since Thomas Blake refused

to confirm he was the child's father was not punished by the Court but left to the censure of the Church.

This punishment was usually severe but it did not discourage the populace at all since further cases of illegitimacy appeared regularly in the Court records and Parish registers.

This brings to mind, the alleged illegitimate son of Mary Hollyman in Clevedon in 1763: the son who does not appear to have been baptised but whose 'burial' was. Mary was the daughter of the parish overseer and a churchwarden and also the grand daughter of the elder John Hollyman

The Parish Church of St Andrews.Clevedon

Also known as The Old Church, St Andrews was named after the patron saint of fishermen and it is probable that there was a small fishing community at the foot of two hills, Church Hill and Wains Hill between which it lies. St Andrews was possibly built between 1060 and 1190 and although Norman, was built on Saxon foundations.

Within the church are two Sanctuary rings and in Medieval times, a person fleeing from summary justice could take refuge in the church by holding on to a ring until his case was held in a proper manner.

Edith Cavell was confirmed here on March 15th 1884 and at the time, she was attending school at Belgrade House in Elton road. Edith became an outstanding heroine by aiding Allied escapees during the Great War 1914-1918 whilst she was serving as a nurse in Belgium. On October 12th 1915, she was shot by the Germans. She was nearly fifty years old.

Although the church is twelfth century, the parish records have been lost prior to 1727. Some say those early scraps of parchment were used to block up holes in the church rafters. There are burial records much earlier and have been transcribed into easy readable pages. The first date and event of these transcriptions is the baptism of Anthony son of John Halse which took place on May 10th 1607. The first marriage is of John Raine and Alice Bradford on May 7th 1607/8. The first burial was of William Ashe on July 25th 1607/8.

According to the date, the last named Hollyman would have been the grandson of John Hollyman the Elder. He was buried in Nailsea in 1766 and was the father of John who first settled in Abbots Leigh.

The Hollyman family burial vaults inside St Andrews have in the main, weathered the countless tread of feet throughout the ages, only one beneath which lie the remains of the eldest son of Hezekiah and Ann, John does one see erosion which has obliterated the remainder of the wording. John lies here but there must be others. For instance, we can find no signs of the last resting places of Oswald and his wife, Elinor nor of John's wife or widow, Hannah nee Churches.

At the time of writing, most of the aisles in the church have been covered with a protective carpet. This may do just what it is intended, that is to protect but it also hides from view some, in my opinion very decorative memorials to the Hollyman families.

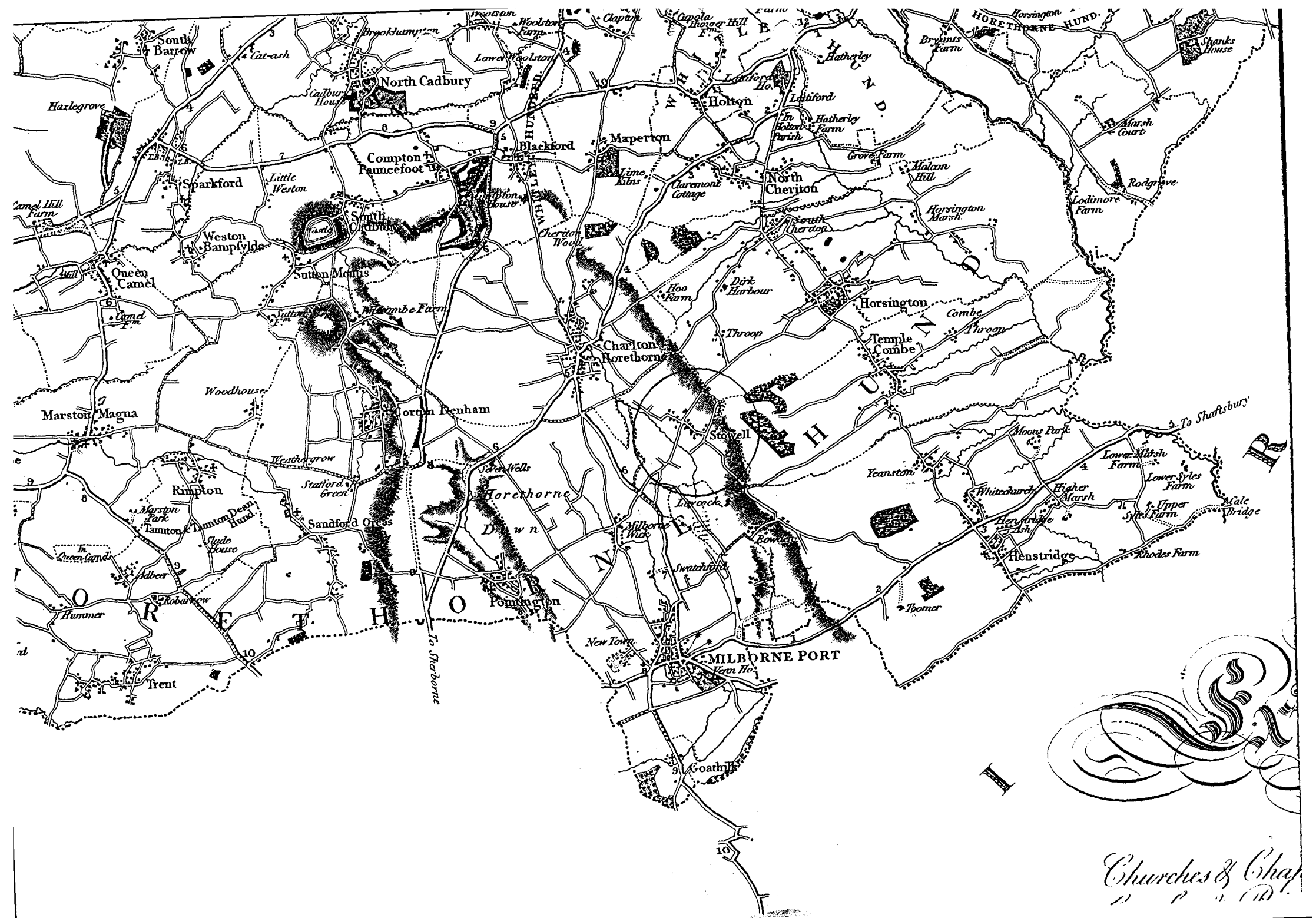

John Hollyman.The second son of John and Sarah Hollyman nee Parsley was born on January 6th 1807 and baptised on the same day as his sister Anstice.He died at an early age of twenty and,I am convinced he was buried in the same grave as his mother in Weston in Gordano on November 6th 1826.

Sarah Hollyman. The youngest child was baptised in Clapton in Gordano on October 10th.1811.She also died at an early age and buried on March 1st.1833 aged twenty one in,I believe,Weston in Gordano.

NB.I fail to understand why Sarah's baptism was recorded in the parish of Clapton when she lived in the Walton/Clevedon area,unless the cleric was less than diligent in his recording.
