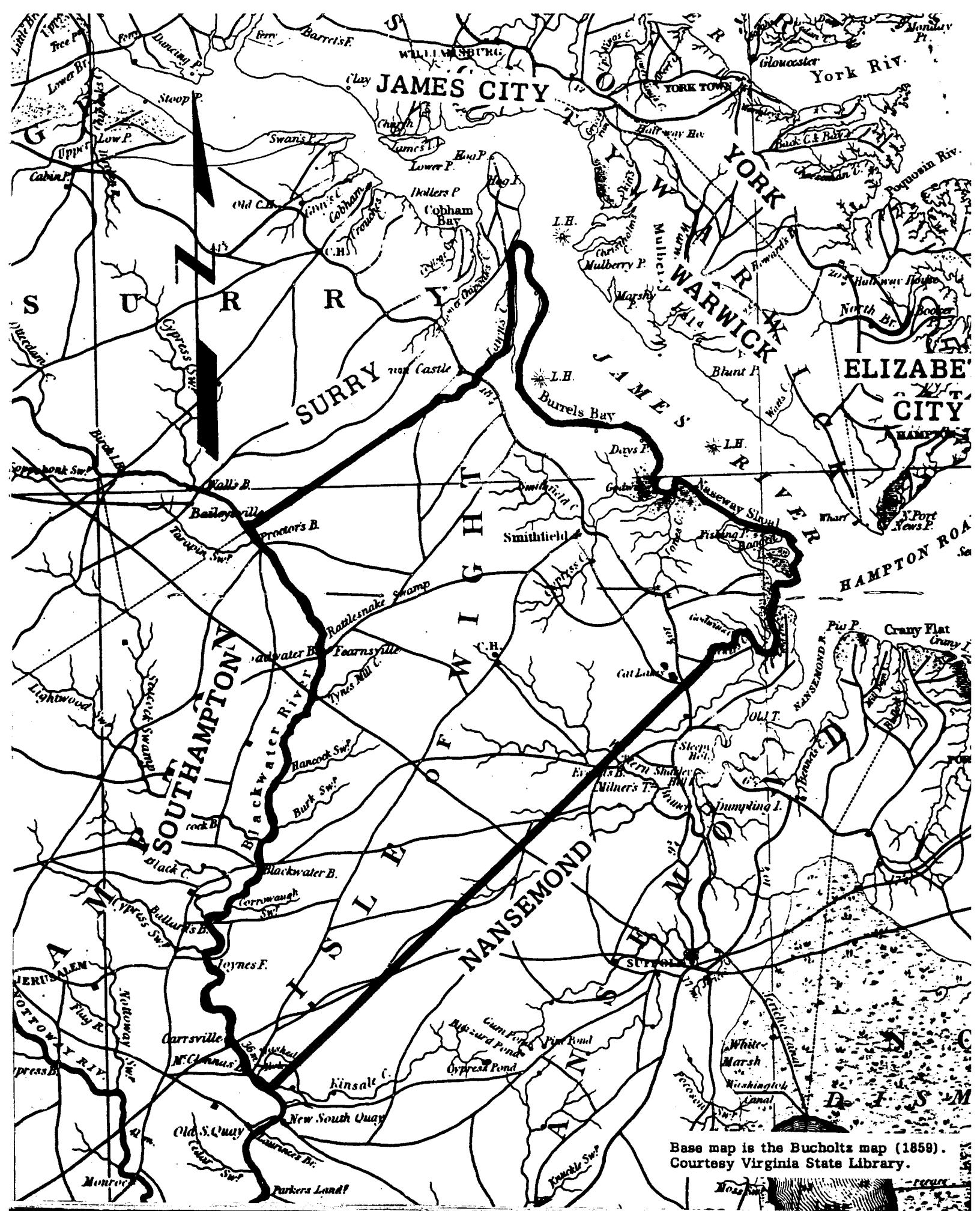

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## PREFACE

The 1787 tax list is a unique one. It is the result of a law passed by the Virginia Assembly on the 11th of October 1786 which mandated that tax commissioners should "on the tenth day of March annually, begin and continue proceeding without delay through their respective district, and call on every person subject to taxation or having property in his or her possession for a written list thereof . . . make four alphabetical general lists therefrom, shewing in columns according to the form hereto also annexed, the date when each list was received, the persons chargeable with the tax or taxes, and the number or quantity of every species of property, inserting particularly the names of all [not just heads of household!] free males subject to tax, distinguishing those also subject only to parish and county levy. . ."

This law was different from the prior law concerning the personal property taxes in that the commissioner was to call on each person at that person's residence [before this the people took their list to the commissioner]. He was to make a note of the day that he took the lists. Also a form was given for commissioners to use which had a column for the names of the males over 21 years of age. They had previously been instructed to get the names of these persons, and also of the slaves over 16, but had rarely done so. Additionally they were to note the number of free white males between 16 and 21.

The tax on white males aged 21 years and up was repealed on the 12th of October 1787. Some of the tax commissioners continued using the 1787 tax form for a year or two—much to our benefit—but the 1787 list is the only one in which it was required. This makes it an extremely important list and is the reason we have chosen to use that year as a "census" of Virginia.

The composite "1787 Census of Virginia"—made up of the tax lists of all the counties—is an invaluable tool in locating early Virginia ancestors. The individual county lists (of which this is one) go further than the composite, however. The lists are given twice in the individual county books—once in the original order, then again rearranged by the date on which the commissioner had visited each taxpayer. This second list makes it possible to tell who the neighbors were since it appears evident that the commissioner visited those living in the same vicinity on the same day. It would also seem likely that he stayed at the residence of one of the persons he visited and continued in the neighborhood the next day. However, be very careful in assuming this.

The tax lists sometimes give information that was not required by the law. Such information has been placed under the "Notes" section. One of the particularly helpful notations often made by the tax commissioners was the identification of two people with the same name. This is a problem that genealogists frequently have. Since the commissioners also needed to differentiate between two John Smiths, they made notes such as "son of Peter", "Beaver Creek", or "blacksmith".

Knowing whether an ancestor was liable for the poll (tithable) tax is also often revealing. Reasons for being exempt included: being a woman; being old and infirm (in which case one should be able to find in the county Order Books a law making him exempt); and an occupation of clergyman or professor. Certain political jobs—from constable (at the county level) to governor (at the state level) were cause for exemption. White males between sixteen and twenty-one were subject to a county parish tithe, but not to the state poll tax. Indians also were exempt. Persons living out of the county may be listed because they owned property in the county, but they themselves were exempt except in the county in which they resided. Sometimes the tax commissioner noted the county or state in which out-of-county taxpayers lived.

"Levy free" and "not tithable" are synonymous. However, when the tax commissioner wrote "levy free", he probably meant the person had been legally exempted from paying the tax by the county court. Any time a person's name did not appear in the column to be counted as a poll, we have indicated this by inserting " [not tithable] " in the notes. Some of these were no doubt levy free because of court orders, while others were exempt from the poll for other reasons.

All names have been left in their original spellings, but cross references have been made in the index to unusual spellings to assist the researcher. For instance, Austin—see Ostin, and Montgomery—see Magummery. All such misspellings may not be cross-referenced, so check all possible phonetic spellings.
