1. Samuel<sup>1</sup> Judkins Sr.<sup>1</sup>. Born, circa 1633 (?). Died, 1672, in Surry Co., VA.

He first appears in Surry Co. VA., when on 7 March 1667/8 Thomas Barlow assigned him a patent of land (D & W Book 1645-72, p. 304, Surry Co. VA) (see Deeds p 533)

Will of Samuel<sup>1</sup> Judkins: Leg.-Leaves the bulk of the estate to, Samuel, the eldest son, mentions sons Robert and Charles. Wife Lydia Gray. Wit: Gerardt Gronswold, John Honeycutt. Dated 13 Feb. 1671. Prob. 7 May 1672. Book 2, p. 13 Surry Co. VA. ("Surry Wills" p. 84). ("Va. Families", p. 535) (Boddie "Southside II) p. 287).

He married Lydia Gray<sup>2</sup>, daughter of Capt. William Gray and Mary Unknown Surname, circa 1666. Born, circa 1645 (?), in James City Co., VA<sup>3</sup>. Died, before 1679 (?), in Surry Co., VA<sup>4</sup>.

She died before March 4, 1679. m. Fall 1672 Thomas Pittman, Sr., Gent. called variously Lt. + Capt. Marriage Contract 9/10/1672

2. Samuel<sup>2</sup> Judkins Jr. (Samuel Sr., 1)<sup>5</sup>. Born, 1658, in Surry Co., VA. Died, 18 May 1705, in Surry Co., VA.

Became tithable in 1674.

Signed (by Mark) a plea for pardon from the crown for participating in Bacon's rebellion on Feb. 6, 1676/7. (Surry County VA. Record Book 2, p. 149, shows that on Feb. 6, 1676 Robert and Samuel Judkins and Edward Pettway, and others were pardoned for their action in "The late Disloyal Rebellious Colony" (Bacon's Rebellion). As Constable, he was ordered to administer whippings to Elizabeth Regan and Mary Skinner. (Boddie "Surry" p. 136-7).

15 Jul 1696. Estate of Robert Swett. Signed Mary Swett, James Stanton, Samuel Judkins. (Surry Co. D & W Book 5 p. 114).

*RM* The inventory of the estate of Samuel Judkins, Jr., was done 18 May 1705. (Surry Co., D & W D&W Book 3 1693-1709 p. 339),

He married Elizabeth Petway<sup>6</sup>, daughter of Edward Petway <Pettway> and Elizabeth Unknown surname, circa 1685, in Surry Co., VA. Born, circa 1660 (?), in Surry Co., VA.

3. Robert<sup>2</sup> Judkins (Samuel Sr., 1)<sup>7</sup>. Born, 1661, in Surry Co., VA. Died, 1693, in Surry Co., VA.

Robert Judkins became tithable in 1677.

Petitoned the crown for pardon for participating in Bacon's Rebellion Feb. 6, 1676/7 (Boddie "Surry", p. 136). The pardon was granted for his actions in "The Late Disloyal Rebellious Colony on Feb. 6, 1676. (Book 2, p. 149, "Surry Co. VA Records" p. 144).

In 1719 he witnessed the will of Capt. William Gray.

The will of Robert Judkins: Leg.- To son, William Judkins all housing and Land, gun, rapier, live stock, etc. To son Robert Judkins pewter dish and tankard, livestock, etc. To daughter Elizabeth Judkins, two pewter dishes, chest called her mothers and other things after her mother's decease. To daughter Sarah Judkins livestock, chest, etc. Rest of estate to wife Elizabeth and makes her Exrx. Friends Fra. Mason, Capt. Thomas Swann & John Thompson. Wit: Wm. Potway, Wm. Rivers, Samuel Cocke. His will dated May 19, 1693 and probated Jan. 2, 1693/4 (D & W Book 3, p. 343 Surry Co. VA). (Boddie "Southside II" p. 288).

 Judkins, orphan (D & W Book 1672-84 p.201 Surry Co.)

 long gun. To son Charles a short gun and sword. Sons Thomas and William. Makes

5. Samuel<sup>3</sup> Judkins III (Samuel Jr., 2)<sup>14</sup>. Born, 1684, in Surry Co., VA. Died, 1740, in Surry Co., VA. *appears Titheable 1700 in his father's household.*

The Will of Samuel Judkins III was dated April 13, 1740 and probated Oct. 15, 1740. Leg.-To son, Samuel Judkins, the Plantation where I now live and all land that I have, also negroes, furniture, leather chairs, rush chairs, oval table, gun, sciniter, sword, books, bottles, etc. To daughter Anne Champion, the labor of one negro for life then to my granddaughter Lucy Champion, also to daughter five pounds. To daughter Sarah Holt one negro, and at her death to granddaughter Lucy Holt and five pounds,. To granddaughter Lucy Champion bed, furniture, etc. at eighteen years, or married. To wife Anne, the labor of negroes for her life, and all the rest of my estate. Makes wife Anne and son, Samuel Exers. Wit. Wm. Edwards, Chas. Holt, Nich. Judkins. Book 9, p. 219 Surry Co. VA. ("Surry Wills" p. 84). ("Champion" Vol. I, p. 128).

He married Ann Unknown surname<sup>15</sup>.

Her husband left her the use of his estate and slaves for life. She was named Executrix with her son Samuel. Children:

His father named his co-executor with his mother, and he was the principal heir of the estate.

6. John<sup>3</sup> Judkins (Samuel Jr., 2)<sup>17</sup>. Born, circa 1686, in Surry Co., VA. Died, 1760, in Surry Co., VA.

He appears as a witness on Oct. 24, 1715 (D & W Book 1715-30, p. 23.) and again on 16 Mar. 1726 for Abraham Faulcon's will. (Book 7 p. 764 Surry Co. VA.

Will of John Judkins written 12 Dec. 1758, proven 20 May 1760. Surry Co. VA. ("Va. Families", p. 533-4) Wife Martha and son William Exrs. Leaves property to his sons Nicholas, William, Samuel, Jesse, Charles and John Judkins; to his daughters Mary Barham, Ann Mouring, and Sarah Barham; to Charles Barham (Relation unstated but probably a son-in-law) and his grandson Robert Barham; to William Thompson (relation again unstated but probably his son-in-law) and his grandchildren Philip, Fredrick, Rebecca, and Patty Thompson, and makes his wife Martha and son William executors. ("Va. Families", P. 534-6.)

An unknown daughter who died before 1760 apparently married a William Thompson, who was named in John Judkins' Will. He names grandchildren Patty, Philip, Rebecca and Fredrick Thompson. In his wife's will only Patty is mentioned. (Ibid)

He married Martha Unknown surname<sup>18</sup>, circa 1708, in Surry Co., VA. Died,

Estate of William Judkins. Bartlett Moreland and Margaret Moreland wife and administrator. 16 Aug. 1721 Signed Wm. Seward. John Bruce, Thos. Edwards. (Bartlett Moreland, Margaret's second husband died and was replaced by her third husband James Vaughn. (Will Book 7, p. 394 Surry Co. VA. & D & W Book 1715-1730 p. 971 & "Surry Wills" p. 85) *See acct. of Wm Judkins Estate by Bartlett*

*Moreland & wife Margaret Aug 16, 1721*

Will of his brother Thomas: To my brother Charles Judkins one negro and makes him exer. 26 Jan 1731/2. Prob. 19 July 1732. Book 8 p. 205 Surry Co. VA.

Will of Charles Judkins dated 6 Nov. 1773 and probated in Sussex Co., VA 16 Jun. 1774 mentions sons John, Charles, and Gray and daughters Sarah and Mary Judkins and Frances Hobson; son in law Amos Atkinson, grandchildren Margaret Drake, Sarah and Jemina Atkinson, Allen, Bernie and Mary Dunn; and son-in-law Thomas Dunn.

The 1740 will of her grandfather Samuel Judkins left her the labor of one negro after the death of her mother. She was also left a bed and furniture.

The will of Samuel Judkins (III): Leg.-To daughter Sarah Holt one negro and at her death to my granddaughter Lucy Holt and five pounds. Book 9 p. 219 Surry Co. VA 13 Apr. 1740, prob. 2 15 Oct 1740 ("Surry Wills" p. 84). A Charles Holt witnessed the will, and may have been her husband.

She married Charles ? Holt<sup>33</sup>. Children:

Her grandfather Samuel Judkins willed her one negro after the demise of her mother. WB 9, p. 219. prob. 15 Oct. 1740.

13. Nicholas<sup>4</sup> Judkins (John, 6)<sup>34</sup>. Born, circa 1710, in Surry Co., VA. Died, 1765, in Surry Co., VA.

In 1733 he witnessed a deed in D & W Book 1730-8, p. 306, Surry Co., VA. His will dated May 20, 1763 and probated in Surry County June 18, 1765 mentions sons John and Jacob, daughters Mary, Martha, Ann and Elizabeth Judkins, and wife Elizabeth. *(see Family 178-536)*

He married<sup>35</sup> Elizabeth Champion<sup>36</sup>, daughter of Benjamin Champion and Elizabeth Williams. Born, circa 1720 (?), in Surry Co., VA. Died, after 1794, in Warren Co., NC.

She moved with her children to Bute (later Warren) County, NC after death of her husband in 1765.

She married Charles Barham<sup>43</sup>, before 1758 (?), in Surry Co., VA. Born, before 1711, in Surry Co., VA<sup>44</sup>. Died, 1791, in Southampton Co., VA. In 1738 he was deeded land in Isle of Wight Co., by Thomas Holt, Jr. (DB 5, p. 49). Received many land grants in Isle of Wight which fell in Southampton County after the division.

His will dated Sept. 17, 1783 probated June 9, 1791 leaves estate to son Robert granddaughter Millie Barham; dau. Lucy Deloach; Drewry Parker husband of dau. Elizabeth, g'sons Joel and Barham Newsom and dau. Mary Harris; son James; grandson Joel Barnham, exec. (WB 4 p. 432, Southampton Co. VA). Children:

Oct. 10, 1760. Deed Thomas Williams and wife Lucy to William Judkins of Surry Co., NC for 160 pds. , 550 acres which is land bought from Wm. Bobbit July 4, 1754 on S. side Little Catfish creek. Wit: John and William Bell. (Granville Co. NC DB D, p. 134).

Will of Joseph Judkins dated Oct. 3, 1778 and probated Feb. 23 1779: To my daughter Sally Lane for her and John Lane to buy land, said land to go at her death to Judkins Lane. To my son James Judkins and to my daughter Sally Lane all the rest of my estate to be equally divided between them Exrs. John Lane, James Judkins, Sally Lane. (WB II Surry Co., VA.) (Boddie "Southside II" p. 287-8)

A voucher dated Feb. 15, 1781 in the Historical Commission at Raleigh for 41 pounds certifies that James Egerton was allowed 337 pounds as by report of the board of Auditors. He was a planter and owned large estates.

James Egerton received a land grant of 150 acres in Granville Co., NC, Aug. 1, 1762. On April 13 1772 he received another grant from Lord Granville of 1762 acres in Granville County on the north side of Little Fishing Creek by Benjamin Egerton's line.

James Egerton made his will in Warren Co., NC, on Oct. 28, 1785 and it was probated at the January Court 1786. (Will Book 4, page 34). Wilmot Egerton, his brother settled his estate as accounted in Will Book 22, Page 505, Warren Co. NC, where the final accounting was approved at Feb. Court 1794. Children:
