Swice Uriah has a son named Elijah age 14 in 1860, this is probably the son of Elijah and Gemina. It is possible that the William age 4 in the home of Elijah + Gemina is also the son of Elijah + Mary. The grandchild rather than child of Elijah Sr. + Gemina. I have found grandchild Mary Times listed in the homes of their grandparents.

The Barbara (#507) Hallinian is probably the mother of Elijah age 44, Uriah age 42 and possibly J. C. age 36, as well as Warren and even the Cornelius who is listed as born in N.C. His wife Malissa being at home during the daytime and born in N.C. Herely surey well have given the wrong information. It is also possible that the census taker made a mistake. There are numerous mistakes in this Fayette Co. 1860 Census. We found several in both my Ashcraft and Davis families.

The 1850 Census should give you the husband of Barbara unless he was already dead.

I don't have the 1850 Fayette Co. Census for Hallinians, as I was looking for a Hallinian who married an Ashcraft. It turned out that the Halliman I was searching for married the daughter of John Martin Ashcraft who moved to Arkansas in the 1850s.

As you will notice, some of the names are spelled Haliman, some Halliman. It is all the same name. The original name is spelled with 2 i's I believe.

There was another Warren Holliman in Fayette Co. He was older and is reported to have been the leader of the Wagon train that left Fayette Co. Ar. for Arkansas in the 1850's. One of my Ashcrafts, John Martin, went with Warren Holliman.

The son of that Warren Holliman, Jesse J. Holliman, married Sarah Catherine Ashcraft, daughter of John Martin.

I have this here if you need it. A descendant of theirs is Bonnie Anderson of Klarneth Falls, Oregon.

Bonnie Anderson says that they used only one L. After she checked up on it, when she noticed I used 2 L's, she found that the 2 L's was the original spelling. Her family had dropped one.

Cornelius Holliman got a land grant Mar. 26, 1858. It was # 36102 located in Township 17 South; Range 13 West; Section 36. The S.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4.

Warren Holliman got a land grant Nov. 26, 1858 # 37103. The N.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of Section 35 Township 17 South; Range 13 West.
