He married Unknown Woman. Children:

- i. George² Moore¹. Died, 1710, in Isle of Wight Co, VA.
 He was 78 when he made his will Nov. 30, 1710.
- ii. Thomas Moore². Died, Oct 1696, in Isle of Wight Co, VA. He married Unknown Woman (Eldridge).
 Mr. Thomas Moore granted 1150 ac. Up. Par. of Isle of Wight Co. on the maine Blackwater Swamp adj. Christopher Holeman for trans of 23 persons: Jno Chapman; Sarah Turner; Jos. Cheesman; James White, Tobias Appleford, Thos. Rolfe, Jno. Carr, Wm. Redcross, Sarah Tanner, Tho. Battell, Jno. Rogers, Ricxh. Rogers, Tho. Short, Robt. Webb, Tobias Stannup, Jane Ayres, Wm.
