South Carolina. & Before me personally appeared Robert Longshore who being
 Newberry District & duly sworn saith that the title deed given to him by John
 Thomas for a certain tract of land containing fifty three acres, and one half, lying in
 Newberry District on the Beaverdam Creek bounds on land of William Turner, late
 of Longshore Mary Taylor and Robert Longshore - was burnt in his house
 - it was burnt down, and he further saith that a deed of conveyance given
 in by John Abbey for Penacres, bounded on one side Longshore & the other
 on William Turner was burnt at the same time, and that the said John
 Thomas & John Abbey died soon after, so that he could never get new titles, sworn
 before me this 12th of October 1813. Henry Gray, S. C. - Robert Longshore
 State of South Carolina. Personally appeared Charles Chester before me
 Newberry District - & after being duly sworn on the Holy Evangelists
 - Almightly god saith that he saw John Thomas sign and deliver a deed
 of conveyance of a certain tract of land lying in Newberry District con-
 taining fifty three acres more or less to Robert Longshore, adjoining the
 land of William Turner & Sarah Longshore, Polly Taylor & Robert Longshore & that he
 left John Thomas & Thomas Peterson die in presence of a great number
 of witnesses, as witnesses to the same deed & subscribed to before
 me this 9th day of October 1813

This Indenture made the tenth day of October in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirteen and in the thirty third year of American In-
 dependence, between Elmer Collier son of the late John Collier of
 Newberry District and State of South Carolina on the one part and John
 Odell of the other part. Wherefore that the
 said John Odell for and in consideration of the said Elmer Collier right
 in the real estate of his father John Collier late of Newberry District
 deceased hath granted, aliened, conveyed, and confirmed, and by these pre-
 sents doth grant, convey and confirm unto the said Elmer Collier a certain
 tract of land containing two hundred acres be the same more or less, being
 a part of a tract of land originally granted to John Collier deceased and
 containing five hundred acres, and part of a tract of land formerly granted to
 John Collier the settler on Collier branch, near Collier's Ford on Duckdam
