Dear Professor Kosztarab:

The W. E. Wine Award Committee of the College of Arts and Sciences met on May 15, and, after careful consideration of the more than 50 professors for whom forms were submitted, the Committee takes pleasure in unanimously nominating Dr. Rhodes B. Holliman, Associate Professor of Zoology, for one of the 1971 W. E. Wine Awards.

Our selection of Dr. Holliman was based on several criteria:

- (a) he was nominated by some 30 individuals;
- (b) these nominators represented opinion from 5 colleges within the University;
- (c) the nominators also were drawn from all levels of student rank, as well as faculty; and
- (d) the nominee has received similar support in previous years for which there are records.

Perhaps, more important than the above statistical criteria are the comments contained within the nominations for Dr. Holliman:

"By combining scientific knowledge with a rare talent for teaching, Dr. Holliman generates his own enthusiasm for parasitology in his students."

"His interest in his students extends far beyond the classroom situation, and his efforts in sincerely helping students are not to be equaled."

"His exceptional scholarship and command of subject matter."

In addition to his classroom expertise, his concern for students, and his scholarly accomplishments, Dr. Holliman was also cited by several students for his teaching of informal classes in birth control throughout the University dormitories.

In short, Dr. Holliman is both widely and sincerely respected and admired throughout the University as a teacher; in view of such a consensus, the Arts and Sciences Committee feels that Dr. Holliman truly represents the measure of excellence for which the W. E. Wine Award is presented.


