- (ii) Ric. Browne of Bedford, tailor, & w. Cicely. --a messuage occupied by Thos. Hill, called the Blue Boar, in 'Cadwell' St. in St. Mary's parish; abtg. E. on the tenement of Thos. Hollyman, occ. Barnaby Crash al. Baxter and messuage of Alice Croote, wid.; W. on the tenement o Geo. Ewin; with access to the pump for the washing of linen or other necessary occasions; and sharing when necessary the cost of repairs to the pump.
