RESEARCH IN TENNESSEE

by Robert S. Davis, Jr., director

The lands in North Alabama were originally distributed by through the Huntsville Federal Land Office. However, for the first year of operations (1810), this land office operated out of Nashville, Tennessee. See Marilyn Davis Barefield, Old Huntsville Land Office Records & Military Warrants 1810-1854 (1985), a copy of which is in our collection. Even without this incentive, many Tennessee families moved south into what is now our area.

Where do you go to research your Tennessee roots? We have a fair and growing collection of Tennessee material here at Wallace that can get you started (see our collection guide) but ultimately you will want to go to Tennessee. We regularly have field trips to the major libraries there. We also have brochures on Tennessee sources in our vertical files.

Any research tour of Tennessee has to include the Tennessee State Archives and Library, 403 Seventh Avenue, Nashville, Tennessee, 37219, one of the very best state archives in the United States. Their microfilm of county records is among the most extensive, for any state, as is their collection of microfilm of Tennessee newspapers. They also have private manuscript collections, valuable state records, and various card catalogs that reference and cross reference family information. They are open 8AM-6PM, Monday through Friday; 10AM to 6PM on Saturday; and 1PM to 6PM on Sunday. While in Nashville, however, do not forget to visit the nearby Tennessee State Museum. One of the best state museums anywhere, here you can experience your Tennessee heritage. They are open 10AM to 5PM, Monday-Saturday and 9AM to 4PM on Sundays.

In Knoxville, TN you can visit the McClung Collection of the Knox County Public Library, 314 West Clinch Avenue, Knoxville, TN 37902-2505. The McClung Collection is a genealogical library dedicated to research in East Tennessee families. They are worth the trip, if only for their collection of published genealogies, local histories, and microfilm. However, not to be missed are their large genealogical collections, including the Acuff family papers. The McClung Collection is open Monday and Tuesday 9AM to 830 PM, Wednesday through Friday 9AM to 530 PM, and Sunday 1PM to 5PM. Located in the same building is the Knox County Government Archives, open Monday to Friday, 9AM to 530PM.

Any thorough search for East Tennessee Roots must also include a visit to the Chattanooga-Hamilton County Public Library, 1001 Broad Street, Chattanooga, TN 37402, which is open Monday-Tuesday, 9AM to 9PM; Wednesday-Saturday, 9AM to 6PM ; and Sunday 2PM-6PM. In addition to books and microfilms, their extensive family research are files are a legend.

Dear Mr. Holliman;
Cleaning out my desk finally, sorting papers, filing, etc.
Found your letter mentioning the other names you would be
interested in later. Thought to file this, would send you listing
on wills in State of Virginia, under those names

Now, if ever you need any of those, you might contact
whatever County---, or in my case, when someone asks for those
counties, I get the wills, etc. from Richmond (State Archives)
They have all the big Registers there, but can't put on machine
to copy. They also have the same on microfilm and you can order
them from State Archives but from what I heard one day when the
they told someone they were 12.00---Doesn't sound reasonable.
When my clients ask for them from another county, I take their
big books, use my processor, type them off, and before I mail
them, I sign them as being verbatim and sign my name. I have
had some get into organizations that say "copy of will" and
they have accepted them. I usually type the misspelled words
and also omit punctuation just as they did.

Many of the Court Hosues now, don't allow books on machine. These
old volumes are slowly being destroyed by ripping pages,
fading ink, and damaging binders. Some organizations have
financed different area, for recopying into book with removeable
pages, and they seal the pages in acid-free plastic. But--last
company that did rebinding, made removeable pages all right!
In the big books, there are six and seven screws that have to
be removed. The other company had put a long thin rod through
an adapter, pull the rod, remove any page, etc.

When one of these newly-done books was taken to machine, as it
was propped open, the screws fell out!!! and all the pages went
in floor--all four hundred of them. Took awhile to put that
book back together!
